ARTICLES FROM MEMBERS

ADVISORY ON NEWSLETTERS PUBLISHED BY REGIONAL COUNCILS AND THEIR BRANCHES

> Preamble

Regulation 130 of the Chartered Accountants Regulations, 1988, provides for Duties and functions of Regional Councils. In terms of Regulation 130(2)(vi), it is the duty of the Regional Council to supply routine information to members or to the prospective candidates for articles or examinations.

With regard to the Branches of Regional Councils, the directions issued by the Council which are contained in Appendix No. 7(B) of the Chartered Accountants Regulations, 1988. These directions are on the same lines as are contained in the Regulations for Regional Councils, as aforesaid.

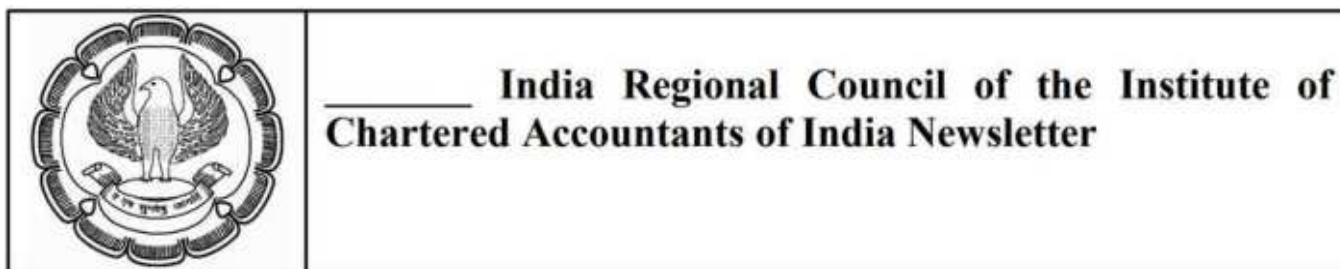
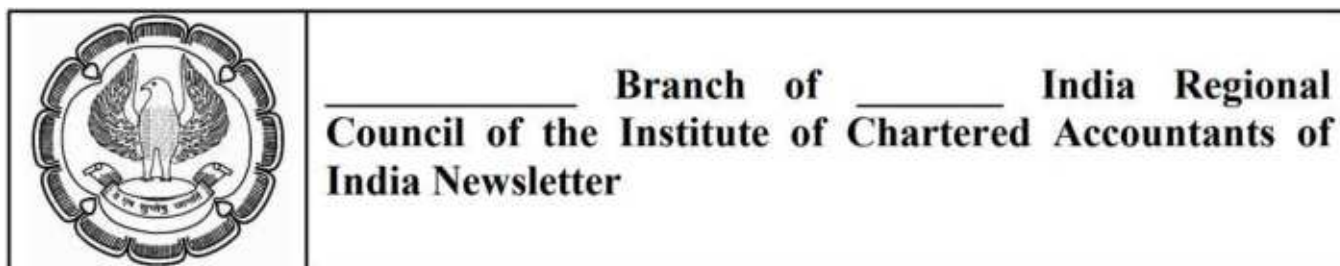
The directions as contained in the aforesaid Appendix No. 7(B) are mainly for the purpose of managing the affairs of the Branches. Besides the above, the Council specifically issues directions time to time on various matters such as finance and accounts, publication of newsletters, stock and sale of publications etc.

In the instant case, innumerable directions have been issued for compliance since 1992, based on the ground realities obtained at the relevant time. However, the level of compliance was not on the expected line: at times violations of these guidelines were also brought to the Institute's notice. The reasons advanced by the Regional Councils and Branches for their inability to comply with the guidelines - partly/wholly, when pointed out were that the same were unrealistic.

On perusal of overall directions/guidelines issued by the Council/ various Committees from time to time with regard to publishing of newsletters; in view of the time elapsed and; having regard to the ground realities of implementation of the same; also from the point of view of image building of the Institute etc., the following guidelines have been envisaged:

General

- All requirements under law such as publication of the Statutory Form, name of the Editor, publisher, printer, address of the Editor, publisher, printer etc., including Disclaimer clause should be complied with.
- All the Regional Councils and Branches should constitute the Editorial Board.
- The Editor shall be vested with the overall responsibility of the Newsletter.
- For the purpose of postage, the Regional Councils and Branches, should mandatorily avail the postal concession.
- In case of pronouncement(s)/notification(s) that of Council or of Government especially Judicial case laws, source should be clearly specified.
- Contents of articles including the source(s) are the responsibility of the author and the Editorial Board should maintain such record.
- The advertisement/s published should not in any way be derogatory affecting the image and the prestige of the profession viz., advertisements pertaining to tobacco products, alcoholic beverages etc.
- The Newsletter may contain either Chairman writes or Editorial. Photograph of the Chairman in his column is optional.
- The photographs pertaining to the programs organized by the Regional Councils should not exceed two-page equivalent space and in case of branches, the same should not exceed one-page equivalent space.
- The Newsletter of a Branch, to the extent possible, restrict the number of pages to 4 but in any case not exceeding 12 pages. In case of Regional Councils, 16 pages but in any case not exceeding 22 pages.
- The space for advertisement, in any case should not exceed 25% of the total space of the Newsletter.
- The periodicity of Newsletter should not be less than a month. No contents of the Newsletter should be contrary to the policy(ies), pronouncements and decisions taken by the Council of the Institute viz., no religious symbols should be used and should comply with the Code of Ethics.
- For the purpose of uniformity/standardization of the Newsletter, the title of the Newsletters in case of Regional Councils and their branches should be as under :

(a) Regional Councils:**(b) Branches:**

- For the purpose of maintaining public relations, the distribution list should also include important Government Officials, Associations, Institutions and the like. To dispatch the Newsletter to the aforesaid categories, 5% additional copies be printed and circulated.
- The Regional Councils should circulate the Newsletter among all members of the Central Council. The Branches should circulate its Newsletter among all the members of the Regional Council and the members of the Central Council representing their region.

Financial

- The Newsletter expenses should be separately shown.
- Annual Budget should be prepared and the same should be duly approved by the Regional Council and by the Managing Committee in case of a Branch.
- A quarterly review of the actual expenditure incurred on the publication of the newsletter should be undertaken. In case of the actual expenditure of a Regional Council exceeds 20% of budgetary allocation, then the matter is brought to the notice of the Regional Council. Thereafter, the Regional Council shall consider the matter for appropriate remedial measure(s), preventive mechanism for future etc. The decision so taken by the Regional Council should be communicated to the Central Office. In case of the actual expenditure on publication of newsletter of a Branch exceeds 20% of budgetary allocation, then the matter be brought to the notice of the Managing Committee of the Branch. Thereafter, the said matter, alongwith the reasons therefor as well as steps that would be taken for recurrence of the same should be forwarded to the Regional Council concerned. The Regional Council shall consider the matter for appropriate remedial measure(s), preventive mechanism for future etc., and advice the Branch accordingly, with a copy of the advice to the Central Office.

- While preparing the above-mentioned Budget, an attempt should be made by Regional Councils and their Branches, to the extent possible, that the Newsletter should be on self-sufficient basis. In other words, the expenses of Newsletter should not entail any financial burden on the Council.
- For publication of information about CPE Programs in the Newsletter, the direct cost of paper and printing, on prorata basis, based on the space occupied and number of insertion(s) made should be debited to the CPE Seminar Account while preparing the budget, and while evaluating the expenses of newsletter and CPE programs.
- The tariff for advertising in the Newsletter should be duly approved by the Regional Council/ Managing Committee of the Branch concerned.
- A quarterly report from the Regional Council to the effect that the expenditure on the newsletter of the Regional Council and its Branches did not exceed the income, be forwarded to the Central Office

Any deviation from the above shall have bearing on the overall performance of Regional Councils and Branches, which may result in to non-release of grant/s payable to Regional Councils/Branches

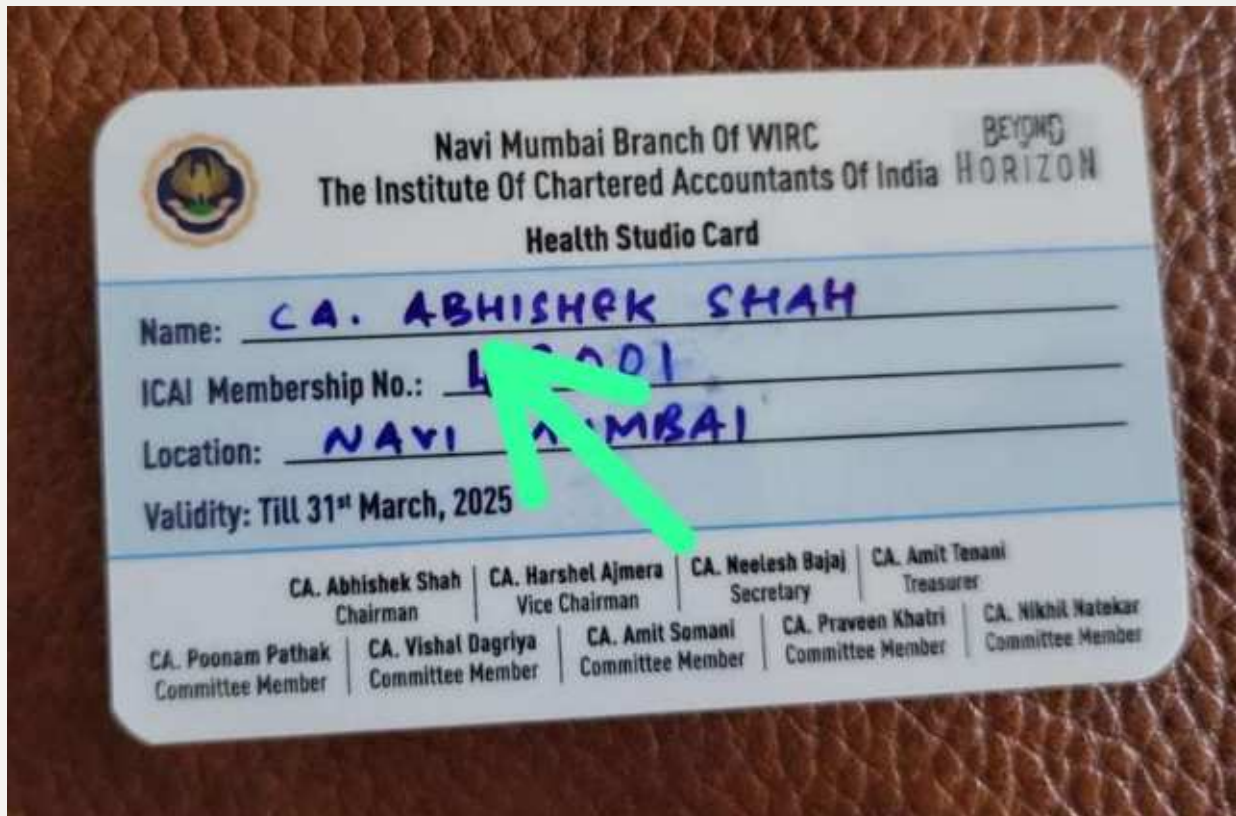

ABG shipyard scam – India’s biggest bank fraud

Initially, the Magdala Shipyard Pvt. Ltd. was founded in 1985 who works in shipbuilding and repairing activities. Later the company was termed as ABG Shipyard under the ABG Group.

Rishi Agarwal founded the company and got registered (ROC – Ahmedabad, Gujarat) in 1985. It has a corporate office in Mumbai and has operations in Suraj and Dahej of Gujarat. The company primarily specializes in shipbuilding and restoration.

The shipyard was able to build bulk carriers, vessels, bulk carriers, specialized defence vehicles, and other big ships. The company had executed many shipbuilding and repair contracts even if having stiff International competition in both domestic and export markets.

ABG Shipyard Company is a shipyard that builds new ships, fixes them, and sells its components. More than 175 new ships have been made so far, with supplies coming from all over the world.

Fraud description

After all allegations and explanations, it was found that State Bank of India with 27 other banks and financial institutions has granted loan and credit facilities of Rs. 22,842 Crores. The ICICI Bank headed the consortium of 28 banks.

CBI Investigation

Rishi Agarwal, Ravi Vimal Nevetia, Ashwini Kumar, Sushil Kumar Agarwal, Santhanam Muthaswamy, and the company as ABG International Pvt Ltd, were the key persons involved in the business.

The CBI had been filed charges of a criminal conspiracy of cheating, criminal breach of trust, dishonesty, and misuse of public position in violation of the IPC and the Prevention of Corruption Act.

Journey

The company had achieved all the success satisfying the customers with specialized work in the period of 1991 till 2005.

- 2005 – The company get listed with an initial public offering (IPO) of 85 lakh equity shares priced Rs 155-185 per share.
- 2009 – The company has appointed Mr. Ashwani Kumar as an Additional Director (independent Director) of the Company.
- 2010 - Acquired Western India Shipyard Ltd in Oct 2010. Company has been awarded with a 'Shield for Star Performer as Large Enterprise' in the product group of Miscellaneous Transport Equipment and Parts in recognition of the Company's outstanding contribution to Engineering Exports.
- 2011 - Company has signed first of its contract with INDIAN NAVY for construction of Cadet Training Ships.
- 2016 - Revenues were Rs 16.40 crore in 2016-17, while debt was over Rs 10,000 crore. The company's loan was first declared as a non-performing asset (NPA) in July 2016.
- 2019 - SBI has filed its first complaint on November 8, 2019. The loan account was declared fraud in 2019. Thereafter, the CBI sought some clarifications on SBI's complaint. In January 2019, a forensic audit by E&Y revealed that ABG had defrauded a 28-member consortium of bankers to the tune of Rs 22000 crores

- 2020 - SBI filed a fresh complaint in August 2020. And the CBI was working on and scrutinizing the complaint's FIR. September 2020 SBI filed a fresh complaint seeking investigation in to the role of public servants and other persons in the fraud
- On February 7, 2022, CBI took action on SBI's complaint. The CBI stated in an official statement that on "Saturday, February 12, it searched 13 places in Surat, including the homes of the accused, including private firm directors."

Journey

- As per MCA, Mr. Rishi Agarwal was also a director of Vadraj Energy (Gujrat) Ltd, Vadraj Cement Ltd and ABG International Pvt Ltd.

Section 80C series of Income Tax Act – Why such deductions is provided by the Government?

After end of every Financial Year, i.e. after 31st March Income Tax Department under the guidance of Finance Ministry of GOI issues different Income Tax Return for every class of assessee. In total 7 different ITRs have been notified by the Income Tax so far.

As per the requirement different ITRs have different deadline until and unless extended by the Finance Department of GOI.

In this article we shall discuss about the section 80C series and see how it works and the motive of the Finance Department behind giving such deduction to assessee. Chapter VIA of Income Tax Act contains all the deductions which an assessee can claim while filing the Income Tax return.

The following clears the subsections of 80C which we will discuss:

- 80C – Investment in LIP, Deposit in PPF/SPF/RPF etc
- 80CCC – Contribution to certain Pension Fund
- 80CCCD(1) – Contribution to NPS of Government.
- 80CCE – Aggregate deduction allowed
- 80CCD(1B) – Contribution to NPS notified by the Central Government
- 80CCD(2) – Contribution by Employer to NPS of its Employee.

In a Financial year on the earnings of assessee a particular ITR is filled and on the Gross Total Income determined in computation he is required to pay Income Tax. But here Govt gives an opportunity to the assessee to claim deduction only and only if he has made some investment in the particular Financial Year of which computation is being made. The said Investment up to a certain limit gets deduct from the Gross Total Income (GTI) and tax liability gets reduced which ultimately gives a relief to the assessee

Here we take a look at 80C series:

1. Section 80C : Following investment if done by the assessee than the same is eligible for 80C –

- a. Life Insurance Premiums paid for Self, Spouse, Dependent Children etc
- b. Deposit to Public Provident Fund
- c. NABARAD Rural Bond
- d. Unit Linked Insurance Plans (ULIPs)
- e. National Savings Certificate
- f. Tax Saving Fixed Deposit (Min Lock - in Period = 5 Years)
- g. Employee Provident Fund
- h. Infrastructure Bonds (Min Amount invested if Greater than Rs. 20,000 than eligible)
- i. Equity Linked saving Scheme (3 Year lock in Period)
- j. Senior Citizens Savings Scheme
- k. Principal repayment made towards home Loan
- l. Stamp duty and registration Charges
- Sukanya Samridhi Yojana

The Maximum Limit all together an assessee can claim is – Rs. 1,50,000

2. Section 80CCC : Few Pensions Fund has been listed, if an assessee is investing or renewing the same fund then the assessee is eligible to claim deduction in the said section.

The Maximum Limit all together an assessee can claim is – Rs. 1,50,000

3. Section 80CCD(1) : If the assessee in the financial year invest in Specified Pension Fund than to a limit of the investment deductions can be claimed. As of now Atal Pension Yojana (APY) has been notified by the government.

- a. If the individual is employed by the Central Govt on or after 01.04.2004
- b. An individual is employed by any other employer
- c. Any other individual – 20% of GTI

4. Section 80CCE : This section provide an aggregate deduction which is as follows:

80C + 80CCC + 80CCD(1) = Maximum Deduction can be allowed is Rs. 1,50,000

5. Section 80CCD(1B) : Provides additional deduction to assessee other than 80CCE if assessee invest in National Pension Scheme notified by Central Government.

The Maximum Limit all together an assessee can claim is – Rs.50,000

6. Section 80CCD(2) : Two cases stated which are as follows:

- a. If the contribution is done by the Central Government to its NPS of their employees: Deduction will be 14% of the Salary.
- b. If the contribution is done by any other employee to its NPS of their employees: Deduction will be 10% of the Salary.

If we see after a discussion max deduction which can be claimed by an assessee is:

- **80CCE = Rs. 1,50,000 (+)**
- **80CCD(1B) = Rs. 50,000 (+)**
- **80CCD(2) = 14% or 10% of the Salary as the case may be**

Till now we have discussed about the Benefit of an assessee if proper tax planning is done by him. Now if we see from Government point of view why such deductions is provided by the government, the answer might be as follows:

- 1.To claim such deduction an assessee need to invest in the sachems, hence with the help of above investments Banking sector received money which is used for re-investment on which further income is generated in the form of Interest Income.
- 2.The same invested money Govt will put in infrastructure plans and will get benefited on completion.
- 3.Due to this cycle of circulation of money, economy of the country gets a positive affect and moves upward way.
- 4.With the money invested in the above schemes Govt can expand different projects, Funds existing projects and as a developing country the soon the projects are completed the more the economy grows.
5. As we can see deduction is also available on premium paid on LIC, which encourages assessee to take Life insurance from a recognized Insurance Company. With this the assessee gets the Life Insurance cover of a lumpsum amount and Insurance company gets a monthly fixed amount which they re-invest in projects hence the same leads to an economic development.

The crux of providing deduction under section 80C series is to motivate the assessee for investing into the recognized schemes, Bonds, insurance scheme so that the best use of that money can be done through a proper legalized way to earn the maximum value out of it. Hence at the outset, through this process of investment and re-investment an overall development of Indian Economy takes place which is the requirement of the country as well.

It is advisable to the assessee if possible than make a habit of investment so that you can earn interest on principal amount and deduction from Gross Total Income (GTI) as well.

Our first and would have been last destination was Bunty Foods (India) Pvt. Ltd.(Parle factory), Ambernath. It has been always a tradition of them to show a short animated movie, which informs us about their diverse range of products along with their respective advertisement. Along with the knowledge of how biscuits are made, following were some of the insights gained:

- Parle reduced the size of the Parle-G biscuit for cost-cutting due to the high cost of raw materials and they have two types of employees, i.e. permanent and contract workers.
- They do leakage test of all batches produced at the factory. If any leakage found, the cause behind the leakage is investigated and production of biscuits comes to halt until it is repaired and maintained.
- The biscuits which get rejected due to different reasons are then sold via a tender notice raised by the factory which is used as a fodder for animals.
- Wrappers or plastics are sold to rope manufacturing companies. In short you won't find any waste in the factory, a perfect example of waste management.
- Parle looks into our feedback also. If they find it useful, it is implemented. Make sure to provide your valuable feedback if any, at cs@parle.biz.
- The inventory turnover ratio (days) is one day. The raw material are converted into finished goods and then dispatched to different locations in one day. Isn't it awesome!
